- 6. Physically fit, able to self rescue and have endurance
- 7. Camping and outdoor cooking skills
- 8. Passion for interpretation of wild-land areas and river systems
- 9. Provide a positive role model for children and facilitate kid-friendly activities
- 10. Know your role on each trip and work with team members to achieve trip goals
- 11. Address and resolve conflict in a timely and mature manner
- 12. Gives and receives feedback in a positive, constructive and professional way
